## Description

The Alton Main House project was a reconstruction of an existing home and garage/guest house. The site development's main objective was to blend the home into the hillside. New vehicular and pedestrian spaces were created providing a great deal of privacy for the owners. In addition, several exterior pedestrian spaces were developed as complements to the interior spaces giving the house a much larger feel, while truly integrating the building with the land. These exterior spaces included an outdoor bar, kitchen and dining area, fire pit patio looking out to the panoramic Madison Range, a secluded hot tub getaway, basketball court, perennial garden niche and hillside overlook. Foley Group was responsible for grading and drainage plans, irrigation plans, all exterior patio and drive design, landscape design, lighting design and site detailing.

Moss rock boulders from the ranch were utilized in conjunction with large stone slabs and pavers. The majority of the site was reclaimed with native bunch grasses, forbs and perennial flowers. Small groves of Aspen and Dogwood were utilized to soften the home and provide an intimate feel in several locations.
